TempO and PreO competitions are WRE (World Ranking Event) event, and Hungarian Championships.

29th October, Saturday

9:00 - Opening of the Competition Centre in Göd

9:00 – TempO Model Station is open (self-service)

10:00 – Start of TempO (WRE) competition

30th October, Sunday

Attention! Clock change at dawn, 1 hour back!

9:00 - Opening of the Competition Centre in Göd

10:00 – Start of PreO (WRE) competition

14:30 - Prize giving ceremony

Maps: ISSprOM 2019-2, scale 1:4000 / 1 m. Maps are printed on Pretex paper. Therefore, the PreO maps will not be protected in plastic covers. If you want, you can bring your own plastic cover.

Special symbol: black o - pylon; black x : man made item

In the last week, a learning trail was inaugurated, and small informative boards will be displayed. These are not shown on the map based on the ISSprOM requirements.

Terrain: Area of former golf course in Göd. A large grassy area interspersed with small lakes and surrounded by forests and bogs.

The decaying area, abandoned for years, no longer looks like this.

Paths: Basically dirt road, few well-passable grasses are possible. Assistants are recommended to wheelchair user. Organizers will not provide any assistant. If you need an assistant on the course, please arrange your own assistant.



Traffic:

There are on the terrain (mandatory route on the course) a pair of abandoned railway tracks. It can be use without fear.

On the east side of the terrain there is a bicycle road. Please, pay attention to bicycle traffic.

Embargoed area: The whole area of golf course and its surround

Zero tolerance: The general Zero tolerance is 4 m without exception. According to new recommendation on some controls we increased Zero Tolerance. This information will be announced in 8th column of control description table. This information marked with ZT.

Bibs: On both days, it is mandatory to wear the start numbers received at the registration.

TempO

Classes: Elite (O - open, P - physically challenged, J - juniors)

First Start: 10:00; Start list

Course: 7 stations x 5 tasks;

Distances:

Event Centre – PreStart:	100 m
PreStart – 7st Station	920 m / 5 m
Back to the event centre (same way)	1020 m / 5 m – Please, keep fair play!

ANT system will be used in TempO competition.

Maps: Loose maps will be prepared at the time controls and TempO stations. If you rather use bounded map or point the answers, inform the marshal at each stations.

PreO

Classes: Elite (O - open, P - physically challenged, J - juniors)

First Start: 10:00; Start list

Course: 520 m / 5m, 32 tasks and 2 time control stations each with 3 tasks;

Free order of control picking in each section of the course.

Time limit: 111' for Open Elit and Junior 116' for Open - Physically challenged

PreStart – TC1	230 m
TC1 – Start Part 1	140 m
Part 1	260 m / 13 tasks
Finish Part 1 – Start Part 2	40 m
Part 2	60 m / 9 tasks
Finish Part 2 – TC2	200 m
TC2 – Start Part 3	120 m
Part 3	300 m / 10 task

Back to the event centre (same way) 1020 m / 5 m - Please, keep fair play!

Recording system: ToePunch system will be used for registration of answers and for time keeping on the courses. Control cards and punchers (or safety pin) will be used as back-up system. Please, bring your own puncher. Some punchers will be possible to borrow at prestart.

Flags: There are some very far controls. All this controls in Part 2 have higher sticks and two flags to increase visibility.

The maps should returned after each part at the section finish. The maps will be returned to competitors after the start of the last competitor

Final results: The results will be both day published online in the top.yq.cz website.

The overall ranking of Hungarian Autumn TrailO Weekend 2022 will be the sum of the point (calculated according to CHIS Cup formula used also in TORUS) of the two competitions. The top three competitors in classes Elite Physically Challenged, Elite Juniors and Elite Open will be awarded. The prize giving ceremony will take place on Sunday next to the Competition Centre.

Prizes: Medals and practical prizes for the best in each class.

Electronic devices: The use of other electronic devices is prohibited during the competition. This is especially true for mobile phones. Violation of this rule leads to disqualification.

Weather: Temperatures are expected to range between: Sun: 20°C and Night: 7°C
