Date: 26th and 27th August 2023.

Place: Öskü, Hungary (link)

- Budapest Airport 130 km (90' with car)
- Bratislava Airport 170 km (135' with car)
- Wien Airport 180 km (135'" with car)
- the nearest cities are: Veszprém 18 km, Székesfehérvár 30 km

Competition Center: Öskü, Péti-hegy (Öskü - Pét, összekötő földút ; GPS: 47.1529, 18.0894)

Accessible toilet will be available in the Competition Center. We plan to set up a tent for luggage and in case of rain.

Program:

TempO and PreO competitions are WRE (World Ranking Event) event, and Hungarian Championships.

26th August, Saturday

10:00 - Opening of the Competition Centre near Öskü

10:00 – Model Event is open (self-service)

11:00 – Start of PreO (WRE) competition

- 27th August, Sunday
 - 9:00 Opening of the Competition Centre near Öskü
 - 10:00 Start of TempO (WRE) competition
 - 10:00 Start of PreO Sprint (between last station and event center)
 - 14:30 Prize giving ceremony

Maps: ISSprOM 2019-2, scale 1:4000 / 2,5 m. New maps, based laserscan datas. Maps are printed on Pretex paper. Therefore, the PreO maps will not be protected in plastic covers. If you want, you can bring your own plastic cover.

The most of bushes are drawn on the map, but there are some small bushes that cannot be represented.

Terrain: Area of former military ground with lot of hills and rocks. Basically open and semi-open areas with good visibility.

Paths: Basically dirty road, few well-passable grasses are possible. Assistants are recommended to wheelchair user, especially in the TempO competition (more info about at the daily infos). Organizers will not provide any assistant. If you need an assistant on the course, please arrange your own assistant.

Embargoed area: The whole area of Hungarian TrailO Weekend 2023 is embargoed because of World Orienteering Championship 2027. The competitors are only allowed to use only road, that are taped for this event or allowed road on the course map or TempO overview maps! https://eventor.orienteering.org/Events/Show/7931



Zero tolerance: The general Zero tolerance is 4 m without exception. According to new recommendation on some controls we increased Zero Tolerance. This information will be announced in 8th column of control description table. This information marked with ZT.

Bibs: On both days, it is mandatory to wear the start numbers received at the registration.

Model Event

On Saturday, before the PreO event, a PreO model event with 5 tasks is available between the Event Center and the PreO start. Map and Solution map will be in the entry package.

PreO

Classes: Elite (O - open, P - physically challenged, J - juniors)

First Start: 11:00; Startlist will be published later. We don't use a strict startlist. If there is a free place, anyone can start, but the competitor who arrives at her own start time will have priority.

Course: 1000 m / 5m, 31 tasks and 2 time control stations before the course, each with 3 tasks;

Free order of control picking in each section of the course.

Time limit: 123' for Open Elit and Junior 133' for Open – Physically challenged

Distances:

Event Centre – TC1:	820 m / 20 m (dirty road, stony, for wheelchair a little bit difficult)
TC1 – TC2	170 m / 10 m (dirty road, stony, for wheelchair a little bit difficult)
TC2 – Start	100 m / 0
Course	1000 m / 5 m

Back to the event centre (same way) 1700 m / 10 m - Please, keep fair play!

Special parkingplace for wheelchair users: There are a small place direct before TC1, where 4-5 car could park. Due to the small and narrow space, please return the car as soon as possible after the competitors gets out.

Path: On the course is the path dirty road with good quality.

Recording system: ToePunch system will be used for registration of answers and for time keeping on the courses. Control cards and punchers (or safety pin) will be used as back-up system. Please, bring your own puncher. Some punchers will be possible to borrow at prestart.

Flags: There are more far tasks (more than 100 m). On the map of each such task, we marked the greater (8m) zero tolerance in control description in the 8th column.

TempO

Classes: Elite (O - open, P - physically challenged, J - juniors)

First Start: 10:00; Startlist will be published later. We don't use a strict startlist. If there is a free place, anyone can start, but the competitor who arrives at her own start time will have priority.

Course: 7 stations x 5 tasks;

Distances:

Event Centre – PreStart:	1050 m / 30 m
PreStart – 7st Station	800 m / 5 m (mainly sloping)
7st Station – PreO Sprint Start	125 m / 12,5 m
PreO Sprint course	60 m / 2,5 m
Back to the event centre	800 m / 2,5 m – Please, keep fair play!

Path: The first part of route between Station is a small good dirty path. The second part leads down an abandoned road, in some places heavily grassy due to recent rains. Please help together and the wheelchair users.

ANT system will be used in TempO competition.

Maps: Loose maps will be prepared at the time controls and TempO stations. If you rather use bounded map or point the answers, inform the marshal at each stations.

Flags: There are some far tasks (more than 100 m). On the map of each such task (Station1,2,5 and 6), we marked the greater (8m) zero tolerance with red text.



Station 1: To the left of the viewpoint, far away, you can see some more flags. We mark the sector of the station with tape on the ground.

PreO Sprint

Classes: Elite (O - open, P - physically challenged, J - juniors)

First Start: 10:00; Without startlist, after the end of TempO station

Course: 60 M / 20 (A-Z) tasks;

Time limit: 30' for all

Distances: see at TempO

Path: Between last TempO Station and PreO start it is an abandoned path. The Course is grassy without path, the usable area will be bordered with tapes..

Recording system: ToePunch system will be used for registration of answers and for time keeping on the courses. Control cards and punchers (or safety pin) will be used as back-up system. Please, bring your own puncher. Some punchers will be possible to borrow at prestart.

Flags: There are more far tasks (more than 100 m). On the map of each such task, we marked the greater (8m or 12 m) zero tolerance in control description in the 8th column.

Classification by total points (one point for each correctly solved control) minus a penalty of 1 point for each 1 min or fraction used past the maximum allowed time. Total time used on the course will be used as a tiebreaker.

Results

The results will be both day published online in the top.yq.cz website.

The overall ranking of Hungarian TrailO Weekend 2023 will be the sum of the point (calculated according to CHIS Cup formula used also in TORUS) of the three competitions. The top three competitors in classes Elite Physically Challenged, Elite Juniors and Elite Open will be awarded. The prize giving ceremony will take place on Sunday next to the Competition Centre.

Prizes: Medals and practical prizes for the best in each class.

Electronic devices: The use of other electronic devices is prohibited during the competition. This is especially true for mobile phones. Violation of this rule leads to disqualification.

Weather: August is a warm month in Central Hungary, it brings some of the sunniest days with an average of 13 hours of sunshine. During the Event, temperatures during the day climb to around 27°C and often as high as 30°C, while at nights fall to 15°C. It is a bit cooler in the forest. Average August

rainfall is 71.1mm. Expect to see some light to moderate rain and a chance of thunderstorms in the afternoons. August is quite calm with an average wind speed below 10 km/h. Humidity is also low during August.

There is very little shade in the competition area. We provide water in the middle of the PreO course and at the start of the PreO Sprint. Please everyone take care of sun protection. (Sunscreen, hat)
