

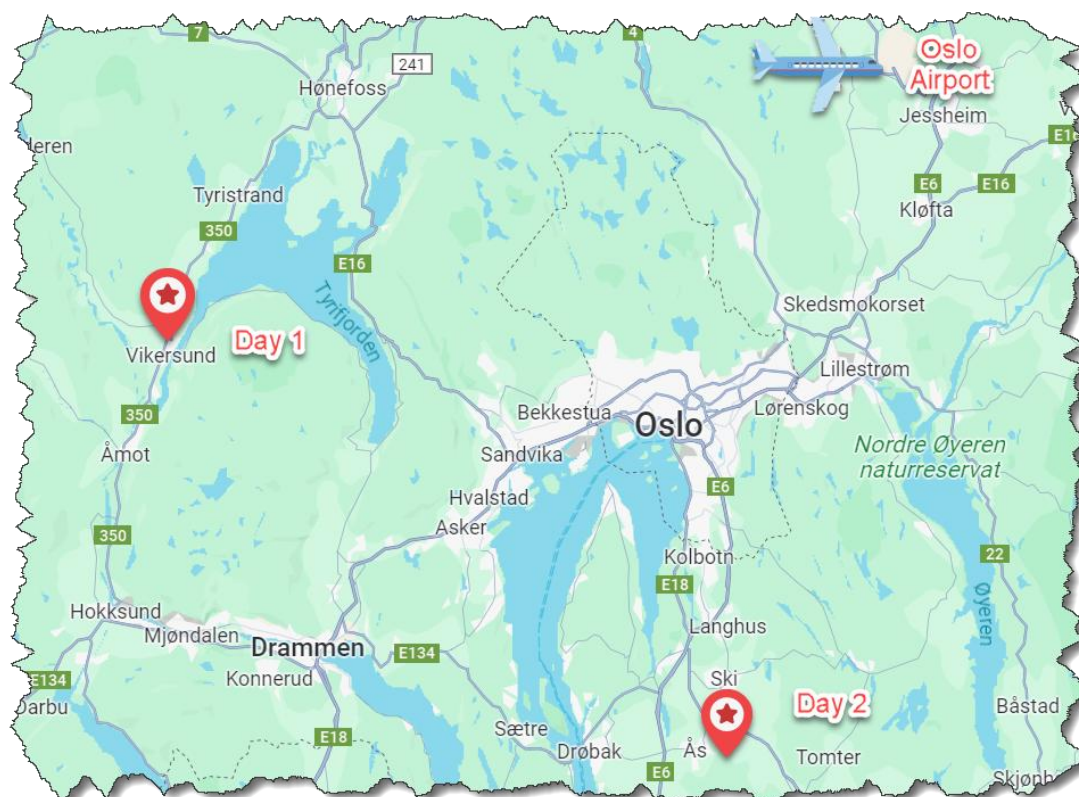
Norwegian TrailO Festival 2025

Nordic Match & WRE & ECTO

Bulletin 1

Saturday 4th October: PreO & TempO in Vikersund (Modum) **Sunday 5th October:** PreO in Ås

All three competitions will be World Ranking Events and included in the Nordic Match.
The two competitions on Saturday will also serve as Norwegian Championships.



Event office:

The event office for day 1 is at Tyrifjord Hotel in Vikersund. The event office will be open Friday 15:00-21:00, Saturday from 08:00 and 15:00-21:00. Bibs and ToePunch tags for Saturday can only be collected at the event office at Tyrifjord hotel. Bibs and ToePunch tags will be the same also at the Ås competition on Sunday.

The event office for Ås on Sunday is at the Ås arena. Bibs and ToePunch tags can of course be collected at the Ås arena for those who only participate on Sunday.

Event Programme

1. Modum TempO, Saturday 4th October

Map: New map 2025 made for TrailO by Leif Eriksson and Per-Erik Björklund, ISSprOM 2019-2 (1:3000; 2.0 m).

Terrain: Classic Norwegian forest.

Courses: About 500 m, 6 stations with 5 tasks at each station. Gravel road.

Arena: Gravermoen, Vikersund. Outdoor.

2. Modum PreO, Saturday 4th October

Map: New map 2025 made for TrailO by Leif Eriksson and Per-Erik Björklund, ISSprOM 2019-2 (1:3000; 2.0 m).

Terrain: Classic Norwegian forest.

Courses: About 500 m, 25-30 controls. Gravel road.

Arena: Gravermoen Vikersund. Outdoor.

3. Ås PreO, 5th October

Map: New map 2025 made for TrailO by Kristen Treekrem, ISSprOM 2019-2 (1:4000; 2.5 m).

The map is based on an earlier ISOM map, see previous map at Eventor.

Terrain: Mostly new clear-cut areas combined with coniferous forest with moderate to high visibility.

Courses: About 800m, around 30 controls in Elite and around 18 in the A class. Mostly wide gravel trail-road in flat terrain with a total descent of 10 metres during the course.

Arena: Outdoor. Details will be published in Bulletin 2.

Travel distances

Approximately 90 km and 1.5 hour by car from Oslo Airport to Vikersund and 80 km and 1.5 hour by car from Vikersund to Ås. From Ås to the airport is 75 km and 1 hour by car.

From a second airport in the region, Torp Sandefjord airport, south-west of Oslo, the distance by car is approximately 120 km/1.5-2 hrs to both Vikersund and Ås.

Classes and competition rules, Nordic Match

Nordic Match, team competition:

National teams consisting of 5 athletes. Every nation may have a maximum of two teams.

Nordic Match, individual: Elite

(Other classes, not included in Nordic Match/WRE: Open A)

The Nordic athlete and team with the best combined result from the three competitions will win the Nordic Match in the individual and team competition respectively. Details on results calculations will be published in Bulletin 2.

Other countries (or any group of athletes) may also have teams. These teams can win the team competition, but they cannot win the Nordic Match trophy.

Classes and competition rules WRE

Only one class, Elite. An A-class will be possible to attend but is not part of WRE.

The competitions will follow the rules for IOF Trail Orienteering Events. The latest version of the rules is available for download from the [IOF website](#).

TempO 4th October and PreO 5th October.

Awards ceremony

The awards ceremony for WRE TempO + WRE PreO day 1 will take place at Tyrifjord Hotel in conjunction with a joint dinner (see below). The awards ceremony for the Norwegian Championships TempO and PreO will also take place at Tyrifjord Hotel at the dinner.

The WRE PreO day 2 ceremony on Sunday plus the overall Nordic Trophy ceremony will be held after the event finishes at Ås on Sunday.
